Riders in FIM E Junior Drag Bike Cup needs FIM E Promo Sport license, annual or one event. Riders with a license issued by federations other than the DMSB must have start permission and insurance from the license issuing federation.

ENTRY FEE	Entry fee is € 300,- for FIM Europe Championship and € 100,- for Junior Cup. It must be paid no later than 15th of July 2025 (late entry: 29th of July 2025 – if accepted, fee will be doubled) in full as per instructions listed on internet https://www.tw-sportsoft.de/NitrolympX_2025_403250/ In addition an electricity fee of Euro 120,- € for providing single phase (220 Volt) will be charged to all competitors (except Juniors). Competitors wishing to upgrade to 3 phase 380 volt have to request this on the entry form and will be charged an additional fee of Euro 190,-. If not requested in advance on the entry form an additional fee will be incurred at the event.								
ENTRY FEE REFUND	Entry fees may only be refunded: a) to candidates not accepted b) in case of event not taking place c) in case a class is cancelled

FIRE EXTINGUISHERS	Please be advised that ALL COMPETITORS must have a fire extinguisher within their pit area to conform to Health & Safety requirements. This is in addition to any fire extinguisher systems within race vehicles. A minimum of 4 kg extinguisher is required, preferably powder. Failure to comply with this instruction could result in exclusion from the race event.								
TECHNICAL CONTROL & OFFICIAL RIDERS MEETING	No rider or machine is permitted onto the dragstrip unless he/it has passed the technical inspections and attended an official Riders Meeting, which will be held according to the following schedule. Any absence, late arrival or early departure will result in a fine of 250 Euro applied by FIM EUROPE Jury. The organiser will pay an additional travel allowance for foreign participants (riders not holding a licence in the country of the organiser) according to the FIM Europe Drag Bike European Championship Rules 2025 Art. 11.13.2. To be eligible for prize money or travel expenses, each rider must pay a championship registration entry fee of 650 Euros + VAT. The fee should be paid to the promoter/Championship administrator 30 days before the first race in which the rider competes. This registration fee is in addition to all normal race entry fees. PRIZE GIVING	A prize giving ceremony will take place at the dragstrip soonest after the expiration of the protest time on Sunday 25th of August (19:00). Winner and Runner Up's are required to attend or risk a €100 penalty. Trophies and Awards will be presented at the awards ceremony on 25th of August. Prize money and travel expenses will be paid by wire bank transfer. We need a copy of the passport and all necessary receipts. The documents have to be submitted with the entry or via mail to Raceoffice.NOX@hockenheimring.de. No payouts at the event.		
PROTESTS & APPEALS	All protests must be made in accordance with the requirements of the FIM E Disciplinary and Arbitration Code and be accompanied by a fee of Euro 350.-

REFUELING	Refueling must be done with utmost care, with a fire extinguisher close by. Disposing of oil and fuel leftovers must be deposited at a special place designated for that purpose. Non observance may result in disqualification from the event.		
PADDOCK SILENCE AND SPEED LIMIT	Paddock silence (no competition engines running) must be respected between 20.00 and 09.00 every night. Speed limit in the pits 5 mph 10 km/h. Non observance of any one of these rules may result in disqualification from the event.

PUBLICITY	The organiser reserves the rights to display publicity on the machines in accordance with article 60.7 of the FIM Europe Sporting Code.
